The Board of Education of the Troy City School District met in regular session at the Troy Board of Education Office, 500 N. Market Street, Troy, Ohio 45373, at 5:30 P.M. on Monday, May 12, 2008. The President of the Board of Education, Mr. James Wilson, presided. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, Mr. Donald Pence, Treasurer, called the roll and the following members of the Board of Education were present: Mr. George Dearth, Mr. Stephen Lucas, Mrs. Joyce Reives, Mr. Doug Trostle and Mr. James Wilson. Also in attendance were Mr. Tom Dunn, Superintendent, four administrators and several visitors.

MOMENT OF SILENCE

Cindy Clark passed away at 7:27 a.m. on Tuesday, May 6, 2008 at Hospice of Dayton. Cindy was a graduate of Martinsville High School, Martinsville, IN. She received a Bachelors and Masters Degree in Education from Urbana University and was honored as class Salutatorian. She was a second grade teacher at Forest Elementary School and taught previously at Van Cleve Elementary. Cindy was recognized as Teacher of the Year in Miami County in 2004.

PRESENTATIONS

The Board held a reception for retirees prior to the meeting. At the meeting, Mr. Dunn introduced each attending staff member and presented them with certificates of appreciation.

Under provision of law, boards of education may grant a diploma to veterans who left high school prior to graduating to serve in World War II, the Korean Conflict, or the Vietnam Conflict. In accordance with this law, the board granted a diploma to Kenneth Paul Voris, who joined the Navy in 1956 to serve in the Korean Conflict. Mr. Voris accepted his diploma with his daughter and grandson in attendance.

Michael Ham, junior at Troy High School, will be competing at the FCCLA (Family, Careers, and Community Leaders of America) National STAR Event competition in Orlando, Florida on July 12-18. He practiced the speech he plans to give in that competition in front of the board. The topic of the speech was how things have changed for disabled people in the United States since FDR's presidency. This is the same speech he gave at both the Regional and State levels to earn his way to National competition.
