MINUTES

Regular Meeting Board of Education Troy City School District 500 North Market Street Troy, Ohio 45373 Monday, June 14, 2010, at 5:30 P.M.

The Board of Education of the Troy City School District met in regular session at the Troy Board of Education Office, 500 N. Market Street, Troy, Ohio 45373, at 5:30 P.M. on Monday, June 14, 2010. The President of the Board of Education, Mrs. Joyce Reives, presided. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, Mr. Donald Pence, Treasurer, called the roll and the following members of the Board of Education were present: Mr. George Dearth, Mrs. Joyce Reives, Mr. Doug Trostle and Rev. James Wilson. Mr. Stephen Lucas was absent. Also in attendance were Mr. Tom Dunn, Superintendent, three administrators and several visitors.

PRESENTATIONS

- Marie Lozier, representing the Ohio Association for Pupil Transportation, presented Judy Hess with the West Region Bus Driver of the Year award.
- David Varda, Executive Director of the Ohio Association of School Business Officials (OASBO), and Dave Bollheimer, Treasurer/CFO at Northwestern Local Schools, Clark County, who is soon to be vice-president of the same organization, presented Don Pence with the OASBO Distinguished Service award.
- At the end of the Superintendent's report, Tom Dunn commended the students of the graduating class of 2010 for their outstanding conduct during commencement on May 29th. He noted that the administration sets behavioral expectations for the students to include conduct becoming of a ceremony like graduation and that this year's class met those expectations. He expressed appreciation for their behavior and noted that several people have commented about how well the ceremony went and how it reflected what a graduation should be.
- Tom Dunn also shared with the audience the gist of a letter he had received from a Viet Nam veteran not long after the Van Cleve sixth grade students returned from their annual trip to Washington, D.C. The writer of the letter, Wayne Paterson, who resides in North Carolina, shared that he was at the Viet Nam Wall, when he noticed students in red shirts listening to direction from a leader of the group. He stated that this was not unusual, as he sees this same scene play out often during his many trips to the wall. What made this different than any other trip was the fact that one of the students walked up to him, tugged on his vest, held out his hand, looked him in the eye, and thanked him for his service to our country. He said several other students followed suit. He said this was the first time this had ever happened, and it was a very emotional experience for him. He discovered that the students in question were from Troy, and he wanted to commend us all for their conduct and he asked that his message of appreciation be given to the appropriate staff. It was distributed to the entire staff as a "pat on the back" for the behavioral expectations the schools have for their students.

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Troy City School District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE TROY CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT:

THAT this Board hereby determines that it is necessary to levy the replacement and an increase of a tax outside of the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of OPERATING THE TROY-HAYNER CULTURAL CENTER of eighty-five hundredths (.85) mill as authorized by R.C. 5705.192 and R.C. 5705.21.

THAT this Board hereby requests that the Auditor of Miami County, Ohio, certify to this Board:

- 1. The total current tax valuation of this school district
- 2. The dollar amount of revenue which will be generated per year by the levy of the replacement and increase of a tax of eighty-five hundredths (.85) mill for the purpose of OPERATING THE TROY-HAYNER CULTURAL CENTER.
