The Board of Education of the Troy City School District met in regular session at the Troy Board of Education Office, 500 N. Market Street, Troy, Ohio 45373, at 5:30 P.M. on Monday, March 14, 2011. The President of the Board of Education, Mrs. Joyce Reives, presided. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, Mr. Craig Jones, Treasurer, called the roll and the following members of the Board of Education were present: Mr. George Dearth, Mr. Stephen Lucas, Mrs. Joyce Reives, Mr. Doug Trostle and Mr. Tom Yenney. Also in attendance were Mr. Eric Herman, Interim Superintendent, several administrators and visitors.

MOMENT OF SILENCE

 Henrietta Mungle of Troy passed away Thursday, February 3. Henrietta was employed by the Troy City Schools as an elementary librarian at Cookson and Hook Elementary Schools from 1944 until her retirement in 1975.

PRESENTATIONS

- Mr Sakal introduced our state qualifiers to the BOE including the State Champ boys bowling team, girls gymnastics, girls bowling, and boys wrestling. See Exhibit A for the names of the students.
- Mrs. Jones gave a presentation to the BOE about the Trojan Institute, which was developed to offer staff development to Troy employees.
- Mr. Bill Overla presented the BOE with a check for \$65,000 from the Football Parents and Kris Dielman, former Troy student and athlete, who now plays for the San Diego Chargers.
- Mr. Herman discussed how the Race to the Top has not been very active due to the lack of ODE follow up.
- Mr. Herman discussed with the BOE that summer school Physical Education would be offered again this summer but students signing up would have to pay the full cost of the summer program. The cost would be \$175.00 for each student.
